- Tue 5 A fine clear day, blowing a light SW wind
Fred drove over to T. 24
- Wed 6 Continued very mild and blowing a strong west wind
thawed a little this evening
- Thu 7 Blowing a strong chinook wind this morning
a lot of snow gone, water all over
- Fri 8 Very mild and blowing a west wind the snow
nearly all gone. Fred went away to cut
firewood
- Sat 9 still blowing a strong west wind the snow
nearly all gone over, dammed up with water
was not thawing very much today, snow bank
at rd side around the place. Dungen, arrived
from the north to night
- Sun 10 A fine clear morning we all went over to Johnny's
for dinner Mary and her, Ray Harold also was
there
- Mon 11 A fine clear day, Fred cut some fire wood
in the forenoon he went to town in the
afternoon, very cloudy, snowed a little to night
- Tue 12 Blowing a strong west wind and thawing
Fred cut wood in the forenoon
- Wed 13 still blowing a strong west wind and thawing
Fred as before
- Thu 14 fine and clear this morning but the wind to the north
and started to snow with a cold north wind
Fred cut wood in forenoon
- Fri 15 20 below this morning wind from north
Fred cutting fire wood
