- Mon 17 A fine Mild day Fred went to work with the line man R Osborne they are working on the line I planted potatoes in the garden
- Tue 18 A fine Warm day Fred as before I was busy in the garden I put in some seeds and some potatoes blowing a strong West wind John went north to meet the Indians
- Wed 19 Weather fine Fred as before I planted some potatoes in garden blowing a strong West wind
- Thu 20 A fine clear Morning Fred as before Blowing a strong West wind busy in the garden
- Fri 21 Cloudy and Rained a little this morning Fred as before I was busy in the garden
- Sat 22 Cloudy and a few showers Fred as before Blowing a strong North wind I drove to town this evening John got back from the north this morning
- Sun 23 A fine clear day
- Mon 24 Cloudy and overcast we took the boiler out of the ciler and cutting had John very sick in bed
- Tue 25 A fine Warm day I planted potatoes in the field Fred helping
- Wed 26 Rained this morning cleared towards noon and started to rain and continued most of the afternoon John still very sick
