 Self busy with Indians some  
 of them don't have enough furs  
 to pay their debts. They left towards  
 evening a fine clear day

Tuesday 12  
 River opening out in front of  
 the bank self at work. Reports  
 that Mr Alexander of Jimerson River  
 had 3 houses & sled in the ice

Wednesday 13  
 Self busy clearing up the store  
 Cloudy and looks like rain  
 Davis & son arrived also a few others  
 from the north and brought a lot  
 of furs self very busy with Indian

Thursday 14  
 a fine clear day self in store  
 the breaking up in front of ice  
 getting rather and may go out soon

Friday 15  
 River runs weather fine  
 Self in office a lot of ice going  
 down

Saturday 16  
 weather fine River boated and  
 charred in the bend water high  
 2 Indians arrived from the Blue  
 Berry River and brought a few furs  
 they report a lot of snow back in  
 the bush
