self very busy the Indians left  
in afternoon for their camp  
started to sail towards evening  
Mr Baz & 3 others passed down the River

Friday 20  
a fine clear day River going down  
again self busy clearing up the store  
cloudy towards evening

Saturday 21  
a fine clear day the Beulah  
arrived from the Crossing with a few  
passengers & Bright after unloading  
part they continued on their way to  
H Hope self very busy  
Frank Great got his leg broke by  
a knife falling on him a horse  
and was brought down here  
to get out to Peace Couper by  
the Mail Trust
