

Tuesday 7 November 1916

Self as yesterday a little milder today  
and looks like a chinook wind  
Old Montaigne & party patched off  
today after being here for  
about a month. 6 men  
& a frenchman arrived from Spirit  
River. Oglesby brought them  
across in his canoe this morning

Wednesday 8

continued fine the boys went  
for a load of hay self plastering  
the house. A Russian arrived  
from the south side he came  
over the river in Mr Parsons canoe

Thursday 9

a light fall of snow this morning  
self finished plastering all the  
buildings ice still running  
River very low

Friday 10

Self busy at odd jobs the boys  
hauling hay Hanley & Oglesby  
came across the river. The ice  
running very thick and may jam  
any time

Saturday 11

20 below zero this morning continued  
cold all day self in office boys  
went for a load of hay old Mr  
Cantride came up from the flat  
selling beef self bought a quarter

Sunday 12

Thomas & Ireland and 2 others  
arrived from C. W. Pinner  
Self busy with them in store  
all day they had a considerable  
lot of furs after getting their supplies  
they left in the evening
