Tuesday 15

a fine clear day the Boys

in office the Boys hauling wood
Mr. Kraus arrived from Cache Lake
on his way out to Spirit River
the Indians left this morning

Thursday 17

Snowed all day self & boys
went for a load of hay
Ogden left for freight at Cut Bank
River Joe Apparition brought in
a Bear skin

January

Friday 18 1918

a fine clear day started to snow
towards evening the mail arrived
also Constable Finnan arrived from
Pence Camp. Underwood arrived
from Hope for mail with Pack Horses

Saturday 19

a fine clear day boys went
for a load of hay self in office
the mail left this morning

Sunday 20

a fine clear day self busy
up at the Promote

Monday 21

a fine mild day boys went
for a load of hay self went with
him. Fred Koppitz man
started a steer at Mowies
place Mowies in charge
