arrived about 8 A.M. Fanny camped  
at Dog Island. I went down to see  
the Bourassas off, they are going to  
Wabaska. The prospectors that  
went to the Mountains in the early  
part of June got back and went down  
on Uranus Boat the Boat left at 10 A.M.  
for the Crossing

Tuesday 13

A fine clear day, self and Fred  
started at noon to cut wheat at George  
ranch with 2 mowers we finished  
about half of it. we brought home  
a load of hay, it is still very wet
