A fine clear day. John and I went up to the Bay, it was to get to cut so Miller came over with a team & plow and we plowed a garden at 35, and I cleared up some land. Very cloudy this evening.

Sunday 14

A fine mild a few showers. We went up and Miller started to cut after dinner and finished about 6 o'clock at just 35. He took the binder home with him. The Messenger passed down from Hope.

Monday 15

A fine clear day. Frost last night a heavy frost up at the lattermost. We took some mail up this morning and then we went and did some work at the new house. After dinner we dug a well, we went down about 10 ft. Started to rain this evening. Messenger Boat and from the Hope this evening.

Tuesday 16

Weather fine we went up and dug the well about 2 ft more but no sign of water. We went to Miller for dinner. They was busy drinking a few people at Statters.
