I drove over to the H.T.B. and helped Mrs. Wynn with some Indians who just came in. Lunsom & J. Halling sent me 2 loads of fire wood.

Wednesday 3

Cold again this morning. I drove down to the Ranch this morning. Roads very bad. When I got back I drove over to the H.T.B. and helped with some Indians who got in this evening.
